### The Calendar of the Library of Łódź University 1945–2014 (abbreviated)

#### 11 February 1945

The origin of The Library of Łódź University on the initiative of The Organizational Committee of The University of Łódź

Zygmunt Dylik appointed the manager of the Library

**February** – the first address – 10 Kościuszko Avenue

July – the new address – 59a Narutowicz Street

#### 1946

The legal deposit copy from publishers becomes the main source of acquisition of the library holdings

**September** – dr Adam Łysakowski appointed the head of the Library

#### 1948

**July** – the first organizational structure of the Library

October – dr Helena Więckowska becomes the head of the Library

#### 1949

May – opening of the first exhibition: The Library of Łódź University in Social Service

#### 1953

The Regulations of The Library of Łódź University introduced

#### 1954

**January** – the beginning of *The Bibliographic Publications of The Library* of Łódź University series

1955

Building of the new edifice started

1957

The Library Board appointed

1960

The new edifice of the Library – 34/38 Matejko Street (architect engineer Edmund Orlik)

1969

October – assistant professor, dr Bolesław Świderski becomes the head of the Library

1970

The beginning of The Central Scientific Information Centre of the City of Łódź in the Library

1976

Diploma for achievements in promoting the culture from the Minister of Culture and Art

October – opening of the first exhibition of the cycle: The Scientific Achievements of the Łódź University Teaching Staff; the cycle continued until nowadays

1980

October – the exhibition: Czesław Miłosz. The Literary Nobel Prize

1981

October – assistant professor, dr Jerzy Włodarczyk becomes the head of the Library

**December** – the Library closed due to introduction of The Martial Law

#### 1984

**September** – assistant professor, dr Janusz Dunin becomes the head of the Library

#### 1985

Cataloging the books according to The International Standard Bibliographic Description for Monographic Publications (ISBD<M>)

**February** – giving the name of Professor Helena Więckowska to The Main Reading Room

#### 1987

Cooperation with The British Library in London and The Justus Liebig University Library at Giessen

June – the exhibition: *The Social Teaching by John Paul II* **September** – dr Jan Janiak becomes the head of the Library

**May** – the exhibition: Karl Dedecius – the Doctor of Honoris Causa of The Łódź University

**December** – the exhibition: *Lech Wałęsa* – the President of the Republic of Poland

#### 1992

The purchase of MAK, the first library computer programme

#### 1995

March – the presentation of a project of the integrated library computer system for Łódź libraries made by The Andrew W. Mellon's Foundation

**April** – agreement on cooperation of Łódź universities with other scientific institutions

**June** – funds from The A. W. Mellon's Foundation for purchase of *Horizon* library system and the necessary equipment

#### 1996

Cooperation with Forschungsstelle Osteuropa at the University in Brno LAN computer network installed

#### 1997

The project of the extension of the Library edifice prepared by architect engineer Jerzy Wiśniewski and dr Jerzy Andrzejewski

#### 2000

The Library collections included in The National Library Holdings on *The Regulation of the Minister of Culture and National Heritage* 

#### 2001

The project of including the branch libraries to Horizon system

#### 2002

Introducing bibliographic records to The Universal National Central Catalog (NUKAT)

October – a foundation stone for the next building of the Library (32/38 Matejko Street) in the presence of the state and university authorities

#### 2004

The decision on adoption of The Library of American Congress Classification in the extension of the Library in the open access area

#### 2005

Certificated custodian, Maria Wrocławska becomes the head of the Library

May – the ceremonial taking possession of the new building
of the Library by the university authorities

#### 2006

October – opening of the extended building of the Library Opening of the American Corner within the Library

#### 2007

Bibliotheca Magna Perennisque medal given to the Library by The Polish Librarians Association

Opening of The British Library within the Library

#### 2008

**April** – opening of The Digital Library of The Łódź University

#### 2009

June – Old and New in the Library: Cooperation or Competition – scientific conference organized by the Library

#### 2010

The purchase of HAN– the tool allowing access to computer databases located outside The Łódź University network E-course of library training for students

#### 2011

May-June – Scientific Library as "The Third Place" – scientific conference

#### 2012

October – opening of The University of Łódź Repository The implementation of the Symphony library system and the Expertus bibliographic and bibliometric system The Library website available on mobile equipment

#### 2013

**May–June** – Library in the Cell Phone? – the Future of the Library Services – scientific conference

#### 2014

**January** – certificated custodian, Tomasz Piestrzyński becomes the head of the Library

**April** – Prof. Helena Więckowska – the Polish Woman in Science

– the seminar

May – participation in The Night of Museums, the city cultural event



Dynamika systematycznego wzrostu, nowoczesna przestrzeń intelektu, labirynt znaków, magia zaangażowanych w swoją pracę ludzi z pasją – to tylko kilka haseł, które przychodzą na myśl, kiedy chcemy przywołać nazwę Biblioteki Uniwersytetu Łódzkiego i 70 lat jej historii.
